AHS AWARDS AT PHILADELPHIA FLOWER SHOW

An exhibit titled “Nature Amplified”—created by **Ann-Marie Powell Gardens**, based in Petersfield, United Kingdom—received the AHS Environmental Award at the 2022 Philadelphia Flower Show, which ran from June 11–19. Because of the pandemic, this year’s flower show was again staged outdoors rather than at its

usual venue in the Philadelphia Convention Center.
