'Perforated Corten steel steps seemingly float over this lushly planted slope,' says Ann-Marie Powell, who designed the space. 'The intricate, laser-cut pattern was inspired by those found in nature. Calculated gaps accommodate walking sticks and heels while allowing glimpses of the vegetation beneath. Corten's warm tones are reminiscent of natural colours, settling the structure harmoniously in the garden. The surrounding foliage casts shifting shadows across the metallic surfaces, animating the design. Steel is an environmentally responsible choice – being 100% recyclable without degrading in properties or performance. Here, it transforms a challenging gradient into a flight of fancy.' →
