As part of its Hilltop site, to the south-west in its Surrey garden, the Royal Horticultural Society envisioned a World Food Garden that combined fruit, vegetable and herb gardens in a cohesive landscape, to encourage visitor exploration. Inspired by the unusual oval site and its connection to the new RHS Hilltop Home of Gardening Science, Ann-Marie Powell FSGD's design offers an aesthetic and educational experience, including an edible flower and herb garden with mixed borders of culinary herbs and edible flowers. Beds have been filled with RHS vegetable trial champions and AGM selections, and a World Food Maze allows visitors to lose themselves within a landscape comprising differently flavoured plants.
